
## Did you know?

### **DISCUSSION:**

"Fetus" means "little one," not "blob of tissue." It is a life.

#### Stages of Fetal Development:


- Conception ALL inherited traits are determined eye color, hair color, dimples, height, gifts, talents and so much more! With ultrasounds and research, science shows that life begins at conception.
- Day 22 The baby's heart begins to beat with the baby's own blood.
- 6 weeks The baby's brain waves can be detected.
- 7 Weeks The baby is kicking and swimming.
- 8 Weeks All of the baby's organs are in place and the baby can begin to hear
- 9 Weeks The baby has permanent, individual fingerprints.
- 10 Weeks The baby can "breathe" amniotic fluid and can hiccup.
- 11 Weeks All of the baby's organs are functioning.
- 12 Weeks The baby can suck his/her thumb and smile. The baby can feel pain.



## Questions? Write the answers in your journal.

Let's learn more about the humanity of the unborn baby.

- · When does the unborn baby's heart begin to beat?
- When are all the baby's organ systems functioning?
- How long is the baby inside his or her mother's womb?
- What happens at \_\_\_\_\_ weeks? \_\_\_\_ month? (Feet Pin card or brochure)
- · What is most surprising to you about the unborn baby's development?
- Is the baby a human before it's born? Why or why not?
- Were you alive before you were born?
- When does the baby's life have value?
- Discuss the fetal development.
   Pray daily for your spiritually adopted baby.





## Activity: Slogan Poster

- Have the students create posters or cards with Respect Life slogans on them.
- The slogans need to be positive and inspirational.
- The students could possibly print pictures from the internet.
- These posters can be displayed at school for October, Respect Life Month.

#### Examples:

Life- The Greatest Gift
Babies are a Blessing
Children Color the World Beautiful
Dignity- Compassion- Truth for All
I AM-Positively-PRO-LIFE



## Discussion

Have the students share their posters or cards and tell why they chose that particular slogan. Discuss the slogans with the class and how they believe their slogan will have an impact on the community.

## Activity: "It's A Baby...But It's Still Me"

Have each student bring a baby picture to school to show the students.

#### Discussion

Although they have grown and changed over the years, they are still the same person. This is just like the unborn baby- the baby doesn't look like a newborn baby and will change over the years, but he or she is still the same person.

#### Option:

Using a baby picture of a grandparent or elderly person, show that although their appearance has changed drastically, they are still the same person. Our identity is in Christ, not our appearance.

## Activity: One Light, One Spark

- Make the room as dark as possible. Notice how dark the room is with little or no light.
- Turn on the flashlight.
- Explain to the students that although the room (world) seems dark sometimes, it only takes one person to add light. One spark can spark someone else and cause a ripple effect.
- In a short time, we are setting the world on fire with our passion for LIFE!

#### Discussion:

What are some things you can do to be a light in the world? Why are you called to be a light?



## Activity: Young One Model or Precious Feet Pins

 Have students hold the Young One Model or Precious Feet pin. Have the students pay attention to the detail and size.

#### Discussion

- What do you notice about the model or pin?
- · How old do you think that baby would be inside his or her mother?

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.




## Spiritual Works of Mercy Novena for October
